

The University System of New Hampshire 403(b) Retirement Plan Annual Universal Availability Notice

The University System of New Hampshire (USNH) offers its eligible faculty and staff members the opportunity to participate in a voluntary 403(b) defined contribution retirement plan (Plan). The Plan is a voluntary plan that allows eligible employees to make pre-tax or Roth contributions for retirement savings. An eligible employee may elect to contribute at the standard, mid-level¹ or alternate contribution range/level of allowable compensation to the Plan. Plan participants electing the standard contribution level may also make additional elective contributions (referred to as
